3. Matters Arising

VILLAGE bins Item A

Discussion	The council are still considering the options regarding placing bins around the village. It was suggested at a previous meeting that a temporary bin was put in place for the time being. Suggestions have now been made that we make one out of wood similar to the planters that CL had made previously. PL had a resident asking if some bins could be put in place around the village and had suggested that concrete stands with Wheelie bins inside could be an option, meaning they would get emptied once a week. For the litter Picking day around the village, we had a kind offer from the member of the public that says they can try and borrow some litter picking utensils from Patrington. The bins are going to be made when possible and the wood will be sourced.	
Conclusions	Waiting for CL to coat it and then it will be ready to put up. It has been mentioned before about putting a bin down seaside road or getting a litter picker. Now it is thought that we maybe keep it voluntary as the one that took place in February was a great success.
