1. Minutes of the last meeting were agreed as a true record and signed by the Chair.

3. Matters arising — LH to advertise the allotment vacancy in next months Newsletter.

Four applications have been received for the Parish Council vacancy (M. Lenny, S. Mabbett, A. Pannett, J. Fox), it was decided that the new member be co-opted for one month. A discussion took place regarding the suitability of the applicants, LH suggested a ballot, the outcome of the ballot was M. Lenney 4 votes, S. Mabbett 1 vote, M. Lenney to sit on the council for one month. PL to be responsible for passing all Parish Council information on to M. Lenney as he does not have access to email.

SP read the councils copy of the Community Emergency Plan, with the help of members updated some of the information. PL to ask the landlord of the George and Dragon if their premises could be used in an emergency. LH, PL and SP agreed to be responsible for displaying a copy of CEP in both of the village noticeboards. A condensed version of the CEP to be delivered to every household in the village with the next Newsletter. SP to draft an article for the Newsletter before 20 March.

SP to obtain a detailed map of the village.

Potholes — LD to email Highways department regarding the potholes and the blocked gully at the junction of Taylor Lane and Seaside Road.
