

Minutes of Holmpton Parish Council

Tuesday 6 October 2015

A. Wilkin chaired the meeting due to the absence of L. Hodgson.

The minutes of the September meeting were read, agreed and signed by A. Wilkin.

Speed watch was explained by Jenny Gray, to operate this system one member of the PC and at least two members of the village would be needed. The police would bring all the necessary equipment i.e., speed gun, hi viz jackets and the log sheets. Jenny will consult her colleagues to ascertain the most suitable place for this to take place and residents will also be consulted regarding this. All in favour of trialling this scheme. LD to email LH and ask her to advertise this proposal in the next edition of the Village Newsletter and asking all interested villagers to contact her, a meeting explaining how the equipment and the system works will follow.

Rick Buckle spoke about renewable energy, because of complexity of this, it was decided that this item should be an agenda item for the November meeting. PL suggested that an open meeting for this should be held.

The defibrillator has been installed in the village telephone box, LD to contact Heartbeat regarding the set up.

A quote of approximately £200 for the replacement of the 'misted' panes of glass in telephone box was rejected by the PC members. PL suggested that maybe laminated notices could be used to cover these panes.

Results of the village walkabout which took place on 2 September —

- the council are to fill various potholes
- PL to see two villagers regarding overgrown hedges
- from the corner of Taylor Lane towards the cliff top will now be on the Councils grass cutting schedule
