

Minutes of Holmpton Parish Council Meeting on 6th December 2016.

2.Matters Arising:

3. First Aid – the date of 21st January was agreed. LD to book the session.

4. David Tucker – Ward Councillor

Mr Tucker updated the council on the fight to retain the MIU and Withernsea Hospital. He asked if the Parish Council would write to the Clinical Commissioning Group at Willerby (Jane Hawcard) to express our opposition to the closure. A letter will be written and a copy sent to Mr Tucker and Graham Stuart MP.

Mr Tucker also spoke of the threat by the ambulance service of lack of ambulance cover between midnight and 6am in the South Holderness area. This is under discussion at present and all efforts will be taken to nullify this threat. More information to follow when known.

Mr Tucker informed us that FLAG and DONG Energy have large amounts of money available to fund projects along the coast. The Village Hall Association need to look into this and begin applying for grants to improve the village hall.

5. Insurance – the new quote for Insurance is £253.00 which was accepted unanimously.

6. Allotments – no interest has been shown so far in the vacant allotment.

7. Planning Application 16/03924/PLF – the applications was discussed and although the meeting was not quorate, a vote was taken and was 2 in favour and 1 against. Other council member abstained as an interested party.
