## **PARISH COUNCIL VACANCY**

**If you have an interest in how the village is managed by the Parish Council or would just like to get involved in the village activities, we now have a vacancy on the parish council.**

**To apply please express your interest in writing by either letter or e mail to the Chair of the Parish Council by the 1st March. If you require any further information you can always speak to any member of the Parish Council. In order to be eligible to apply the following conditions apply.....**

- 1. You are, and will continue to be, registered as a local government elector for the parish/ community in which you wish to stand from the day of your nomination onwards. See paragraph 1.5 for further information.**
- 2. You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish/ community area during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your nomination and the day of election.**
- 3. Your main or only place of work during the 12 months prior to the day of your nomination and the day of election has been in the parish/ community area.**
- 4. You have lived in the parish/ community area or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your nomination and the day of election.**
