REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY—9TH November 2014

As we all know, this year marks the 100th anniversary of the beginning of the First World War—"the war to end all wars". In order to mark the occasion the Parish Council suggested that a service be held in the church. As we have no permanent vicar at the moment, Mike Cox, in his role as Methodist Lay Preacher, has kindly agreed to take the service for us. The content is taken from the Royal British Legion's suggested service and will involve members of the village taking part. The two minute silence will be a key part of the morning when candles will be lit, after which the congregation will lay wreaths or poppies at the airmen's memorial outside should they wish to. It would be lovely to see as many people as possible in the church to share our tribute to the fallen.

The service will begin at 10.40am on November 9th in the Church.
