Planning	This issue has been brought to our attention at the previous meeting due the fact that there is a natural creation of a new entrance to the allotments due to a gap in the hedge. In which, the owners of the Rocket House have placed a gate to fill the gap as their dogs were originally getting loose There has been a dispute regarding this and in order to get it resolved the chairman suggested two proposals; Proposal 1 – Reinstate the boundary as it originally was. Proposal 2 – An agreement is formed between the Parish Council and Rocket House that would state, that if the property were to be sold at anytime or the present owners of the Rocket House were to give up their allotment, then the gap in the hedge would have to be reinstated.
application	This has been discussed from all points of view. Parish Councilor L.Hodgson was unfortunately unavailable to attend this meeting however did send a letter in giving support in favor of proposal 2. It was stated that it could be a danger with regards to Health and Safety if there was only one entrance, however with this in mind another angle was put on it as another member of the Parish Council seemed to think that there was only the one gate put in originally for a security point of view to decrease the amount of
Conclusion	Due to the process of discussion there was no option left but to vote on the proposals; Proposal 2 – Saw only 1 in favor and 3 against. Concluding that the hedge shall be re instated. It was then asked how the Parish Council proposes to action this. The response was that the trees will have to be planted in the Autumn.
