#### DAVID TUCKER'S UPDATE

· Shape meetings are now up and running. Brian Cloke will chair bi monthly meetings. The next meeting is Saturday 29 October, 11-4 at Patrington Church.

· Yorkshire Ambulance Service are proposing to re rota the crews which could mean that there will be no service between midnight and 6am. He is attending a meeting in York next week and will feed back the outcome the next time he attends a HPC meeting.

· Dong Energy have £465,000 set aside for grants, this is only available to villages which are 5km from the coast, the maximum grant for each submission is £50,000.

· Ministry of Defence Police - their primary role is the gas terminal.

· Holmpton PC should have received an email for dissemination to the residents, to the Harvest Festival at St Wilfred's Church in Ottringham, unfortunately HPC did not receive the email. David will contact the vicar and ask that HPC are on the mailing list for further events.

PL reported that the footpath from the pub to Patrington Road is very overgrown and the nettles which are over growing the footpath on School Lane have not been cut down despite LD reporting this last month. LD to email Streetscene Services again and report both paths.
